Focus 2024

The Focus for 2024 as per below has been cut and paste twice since the March General Committee meeting via the Update which could be described as a veiled reminder. But it would appear after the 1st 8 weeks, we might need to be a little more direct if for no other reason than everyone knows what's going on.

If I were to suggest we are becoming increasingly concerned with any of Coaches, Match Day Officials, Runners and Water Carriers using a match of The League to roll out their version of the League's Code of Conduct, it would be selling it short. (being concerned that is). Generally speaking, the volume of feedback whether it be in passing or specific complaints on the very people who set the tone for how players and spectators in general go about their business is in some cases setting a pretty low bar.

On balance, it is also fair to suggest the great majority of clubs go about their business the greater majority of the time as per their own club specific standards let alone the League's code of conduct and to that we are grateful and even more grateful as we speak given what we are dealing with right now from some.

Because the biggest shift in this observation being brought to the fore is the standards expected by our clubs or their own members who are the source of these complaints are far outweighing that of Umpires or Umpire Observers.

But strap yourselves in because there's a small number of clubs who have had the riot act read to them by The League Executive with some pretty clear ramifications ranging from.

- Warnings – informal and formal
- Fines
- Loss of the use of runners/water carriers for a week or two
- Appointing 2 Match Day Officials
- Recording of Reserves grade matches at their cost
- Employment of security at their cost
- Loss of a home match

Can I respectfully suggest if not plea that everyone use this little mini break to remind Coaches, Match Day Officials, Runners and Water Carriers that at the very least, they are subject to a higher level of expectations than the 32 (Women) or 36 (Men) running around on the oval.

The League's focus isn't new and if there is one agenda item not discussed face to face at the General Committee Meeting that needs reaffirmation it is this one.

As we draw closer to the season, we strongly urge all clubs to make The League's focus a Club focus and remind all Officials, coaches, members and players of our collective expectations to achieve a good day out for all.
